The Ansonia Nature & Recreation Center's Playground Project

Hundreds of thousands of families and school children in our communities have enjoyed the Ansonia Nature and Recreation Center's 150-acre park, hiked the miles of trails, and explored our Visitor Center for over 35 years.

A big part of the ANC has been our homegrown playground, built 25 years ago with support from the local community. On Monday, April 18, the playground was inspected by the City of Ansonia, deemed unsafe, and demolished. This event was expected, but the timing was not; it couldn't have come at a worse time, during our busiest seasons of spring and summer.

The park staff has relied on the playground to provide a second "Education Station." It is an important outdoor space at the park which engages physical activity and supplements the classroom space to allow multiple school classes to visit and benefit from our environmental programs on the same day. The Visitor Center cannot accommodate more than one class at a time, so having alternative outdoor spaces for teachers and students is crucial. The playground has also been used daily by park visitors, our afterschool program "Charger Club," summer camps, and during special events.

The Friends of the Ansonia Nature Center, Inc., our 501c3 organization, has been fundraising for the last year and a half and has raised \$30,000 to date. It is time to continue the legacy and ensure the playground's longevity for future generations. We are asking for our community to come together again to rebuild a safe environment in which our children can play. Donations can be made to the Friends of the Ansonia Nature Center, Inc. (FANCI):
